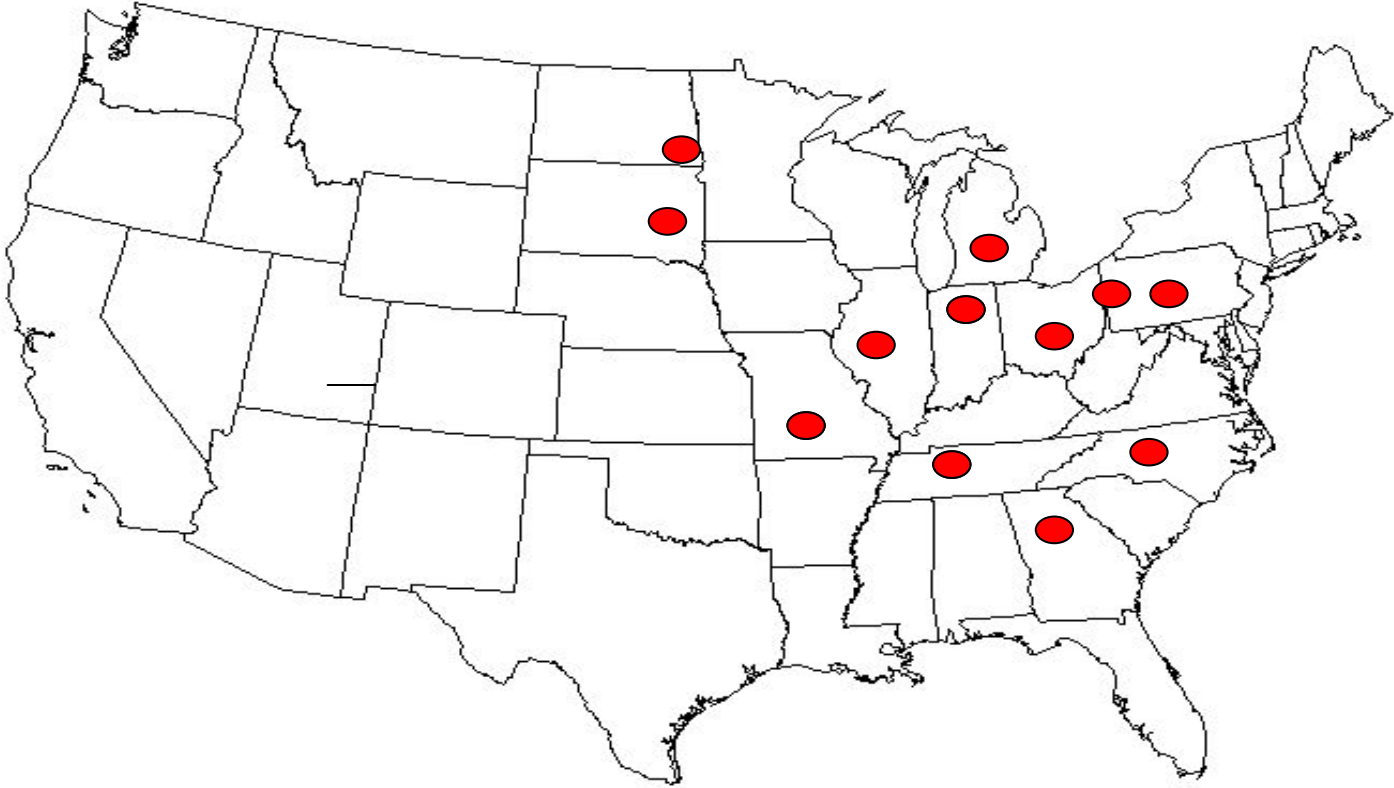


MYCOTOXIN- DON – WHEAT & BARLEY MAP REPORT AS OF 9/2/2010

NOTE: Current map represents crop conditions that are of concern and DON outbreak “potential” in soft winter wheat areas are marked with ○ – Evidence of low test weight, scab, blight and other damage characteristics may be present.

NEW CROP WHEAT: CONFIRMED LEVELS OF DON ● Marked: Ohio up to 14 ppm; North Carolina < 4 ppm; TN & Georgia < 0.4 ppm; IL 1-5 ppm; MO wheat up to 6.2 ppm; MI up to 5.8 ppm; IN 5-14 ppm; PA up to 3.5 ppm; ND > 1.0 ppm; SD Spring wheat 5% > 5ppm and 10% of Winter wheat > 5 ppm

NEW CROP BARLEY: CONFIRMED LEVEL OF DON: Eastern OH/Western PA: Up to 2.3 ppm in Feed Barley
