Supervisor Talking Points

- **As a group discuss the following:**
 - Person at your facility responsible for coordinating the hazard communication program.
 - Location of chemical inventory and MSDS sheets at your location.
 - Choose one MSDS sheet for a chemical or product used at your facility. Provide copies to the group and ask them to locate the following information:
 - Emergency contact phone number.
 - Routes of entry into the body.
 - Recommended PPE for handling the chemical/product.
 - Emergency first aid procedures.
 - Physical hazards (flammability, reactive, combustible, etc.).
 - Health hazards (acute/chronic, carcinogen, corrosive, irritant, target organ effects, etc.).
 - Labeling requirements for chemicals:
 - Manufacturer
 - Secondary use containers (spray bottles, small containers, etc.)
 - Location of emergency equipment:
 - Eyewash stations
 - Emergency Showers
 - Spill kits
 - Fire Extinguishers
 - PPE (gloves, respiratory protection, chemical resistive PPE, etc.)
